

President's Message




Spring is here. It is time to get outside more - Walking, gardening.... What is your favorite springtime activity? Norwegians head for the mountains for some spring skiing.

## **Easter in Norway**

Easter in Norway means lots of quality time with family, friends and of course – lots of chocolate.

While Easter is a religious holiday, many Norwegians enjoy the social and family aspects of Easter. Easter also is a time for preparing for spring and relaxing after the cold harsh winters. It is a celebration of the winter letting go. A common tradition during Easter is traveling to the mountains and enjoying that last bit of winter on skis.

Norway does not have the Easter bunny tradition as we in the United States. Instead, Norwegians celebrate the Easter chickens and eggs. Chickens are a sign of fertility as well as dawn and the sun. Eggs give meaning to rebirth of plants and animals in the springtime.

Easter is marked by the color of yellow and all of Easter décor is done in yellow. They use yellow candles, napkins, yellow tulips and daffodils. Easter eggs are colored yellow and are hung from birch tree twigs.

Easter means games, Easter quizzes, Easter crime stories and Easter decorations for family and friends as a way of celebration.

#### **Food Traditions for Easter**

Easter breakfast in Norway is marked with eggs, lamb, oranges, yeast breads, cakes and lots of chocolate. Fastelavensboller (Bread Buns) are a popular breakfast treat during this time. It is estimated that Norwegians eat 20 million oranges during the Easter season.

## **Fastelavensboller (Bread Buns)**

#### Dough

- 2 oz dry yeast
- 2 eggs
- 1 cup milk
- 7 oz cold butter
- 2 T sugar
- 21 oz flour
- 2 tsp cardamom
- 1 egg for egg wash

#### **Custard filling**

- 2 eggs
- 4 T sugar
- 2 T corn starch
- 1 1/5 cup milk
- 1 vanilla bean seeds

- 1. Mix flour, sugar and cardamom
- 2. Add butter and crumble with fingers
- 3. Heat milk until finger warm and dissolve yeast
- 4. Add eggs to milk/yeast mixture and whip
  - 5. Add mil/yeast/egg mixture to dry ingredients
  - 6. Knead dough
- 7. Cover and let rise ½ hour
  - 1. Add all ingredients and whip together
  - 2. Heat slowly, stirring constantly until thick
  - 3. Lett cool

#### **Marzipan Remonce**

- 5 oz sugar
- 5 oz soft butter
- 5 oz marzipan

1. Mix all together and knead with fingers

#### The Assembly

- 1. Separate dough into 24 pieces
- 2. Roll flat and add 1 tsp of custard filling and 1 tsp marzipan remonce
- 3. Fold all corners up and press to seal edges
- 4. Place on baking sheet, seam side down
- 5. Brush with egg wash
- 6. Bake at 400° for 10-15 minutes
- 7. When cool top with chocolate icing
