Divine Almond Wedges

ALMOND WEDGES: Makes 32 wedges; very rich and moist-Heaven Sent delights.

1 cube margarine

1 cube butter

1 ½ cup sugar

1 egg, plus 1 egg yolk (reserve one egg white) – Use Large or Extra Large eggs

2 Tbs. pure almond extract (this is not a misprint!)

2 – 2 $\frac{1}{4}$ cups flour

1 egg white

Sliced almonds



Instructions:

- 1) Cream sugar, margarine and butter.
- 2) Add egg and egg yolk and mix well.
- 3) Add almond extract. Mix well and then add flour all at once.
- 4) Mix. Spread in two 9" pie plates.
- 5) Beat the reserved egg white until foamy; use just enough to brush the top of the dough in each pie plate; sprinkle the top with sliced almonds.
- 6) Bake at 330 degrees for about 20 minutes, until golden brown and barely indents to the touch of a finger (feels firm.)
- 7) Let cool. Cut in wedges, 16 per pie plate. Makes 32 wedges; very rich and moist.
