Recipe of the Month - TRADITIONAL SURKAL

Ingredients

1 white cabbage2 apples,1 tsp salt2 tsp caraway seeds3 dl stock2 tbsp vinegar (7%)2 tbsp sugar0.5 tsp pepper



INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Finely slice cabbage and apples, and add to a saucepan.
- 2. Add salt, caraway seeds and stock.
- 3. Bring to a boil and let simmer for 45 minutes.
- 4. Add vinegar, sugar and pepper to taste.
- 5. Serve immediately or store for a couple of days in the fridge!

January in Norway

January is **the coldest month in Norway** with normal temperatures that reach inside the 20-30 degree Fahrenheit reach. The more limited days likewise add to the snowy feel. The sun is up for around 6-8 hours every day in Oslo, while Tromsø toward the north is without sunlight for the principal half of the month. But they have a lighted ski trail down the center of the island to allow skiing all through the dark period!
