

Presidents Message

President's Message

March 2020

We had a great lodge meeting in February when we ate Meatloaf prepared by Josef Hinkofer and installed our new Officers for 2020. Unfortunately, for lodge participation, most of the officers are the same as last year. While they have all done a good job, we need new blood rotating into the running of the lodge. So, this coming year, all officers will try to encourage someone to work with them to encourage others to participate. So, if asked, please do! And if not asked, volunteer to help! We do have two new board members this term: Nikki Pelly, Trustee, and Brian Malnes, Publicity Director. We welcome you two and hope to see you at the monthly Board meetings.

What do you think of when March arrives? Leprechauns and green beer and shamrocks? Or perhaps corned beef and cabbage? Edmonds Lodge will be celebrating St Patrick's day at our lodge meeting March 11 with a corned beef and cabbage dinner. The culture activity prior to dinner will be learning to write with Runes (Viking alphabet) and the program after dinner will be a talk by Cameron Widmark on aspects of the Rune language of Vikings.

Is St Patrick's day celebrated in Norway? Ya sur, ya betcha. In Oslo they are celebrating the 20th anniversary of the St Patrick Day Parade! It will be held this year on Saturday March 14th starting at the *Jernbanetorget*. The day, 17th of March, commemorates St Patrick and the arrival of Christianity in Ireland. For a less reverent interpretation, see elsewhere in this newsletter.

March also heralds spring. The spring equinox, Vårjevndggn, occurs this month (19 th this year) and marks the day that day and night are of equal length and thus days will start getting longer (well, in the northern hemisphere). This is a day anticipated with gladness in Northern Europe after a long dark winter.

Some of us still seek out snow. I will be heading for Canada and some spring skiing early in the month. And in Alaska they pray for snow along the Iditarod sled dog race trail. The Iditarod starts March 7th and will use the northern route from Anchorage to Nome (just shy of 1,000 miles). In odd years, a southern route is used. Both sections of trail are a part of the Iditarod National Historical Trail which was used in early years for all winter travel. Dog sleds delivered the mail, the preacher, the groceries, and hauled out gold and furs all the way to Anchorage or Fairbanks. There are three Norwegians racing this year. Joar Leifseth Ulsom, from Mo I Rana, will be racing for the eight time. He placed in the top ten all years and won in 2018 with a time of 9 days 12 hours. Thomas Waener, from Torpa, ran in 2015, took 17th place and won rookie of the year. This year he is running as a veteran. Tom Frode Johansen, from Foruflaten, is running his first Iditarod race this year.

And later in March, March 25th to be exact, we have *Vaffeldagen*. This holiday originated in Sweden and is called *Våffeldagen* there. The holiday coincides with the Feast of the Annunciation. This day was also considered the start of spring in Sweden and Europe. It became a custom for Swedish families to celebrate the two events by making waffles on this day. Norway quickly caught on to this day of observance!

Oppskrift Edmonds Recipe of the month

Norwegian Waffles - Vafler

Cakes and waffles baked in cast iron forms are among the oldest kind of Norwegian cakes. Some of the cake irons have been found with runic writings on them. The oldest waffle irons made one heart shaped or square waffle. Later three hearts in the same iron were popular. The heart-shaped waffle iron in use today traditionally has five hearts.

Here are two recipies. There are probably as many recipes as there are folks making them!

Cake Waffles – Sprø Vafler

4 eggs

- 1 ½ cups sugar
- 1 ½ cups butter, melted
- 2 ½ cups potato starch flour
- 3 tsp baking powder

Beat eggs and sugar til light and fluffy. Add cooled melted butter. Mix potato starch and baking powder and add to egg mixture. The batter will be rather firm. Bake in buttered waffles pan until golden and crisp.



Everyday waffles - Hverdagsvafler

2 eggs

1 1/3 cup cultured milk

1 1/3 cup flour

½ tsp baking powder

2 tbsp sugar

3 tbsp margarine, melted

Beat eggs with half the milk. Mix dry ingredients and add to eggs, stir until batter is smooth. Add remaining milk and melted butter and mix well. Let batter stand 10 minutes. Bake in buttered waffles pan until golden and crisp.

Serve waffles with brown goat cheese (geitost) and/or jam.


