October is Foundation month for the SON. At the Sons of Norway Foundation, we are driven by a sense of purpose: to celebrate Nordic culture and heritage through scholarships and grants to our members and communities. Since 1966, staying true to this purpose, we have been supporting our members through scholarships and cultural exchange opportunities, providing disaster relief to

members in need around the country, and funding community programs that celebrate Norwegian heritage and culture. In 2022, the SON Foundation distributed over \$218,000 in awards: \$133,000 in scholarships for students to study in the US, Canada, and Norway;

\$75,895 in grants for Norwegian culture and heritage programs; \$9,296 in camperships for kids across the US to attend Norwegian cultural camps. We will be putting out the piggy banks at our October meeting to collect funds for the Foundation. So, bring your loose change and bills. And see you there!

Hurtigruten has 7 ships that run North and South along the Norwegian coast non-stop all year long.

Hurtigruten has about 35 ports that they stop at each way. The scenery was beautiful and I got off the ship and walked around many of the small communities. Some of the highlights of the trip were crossing the Arctic circle, going through the Troll's fjord in the Lofoten Islands, which is extremely narrow, and celebrating Hurtigrutens 130 year anniversary.
